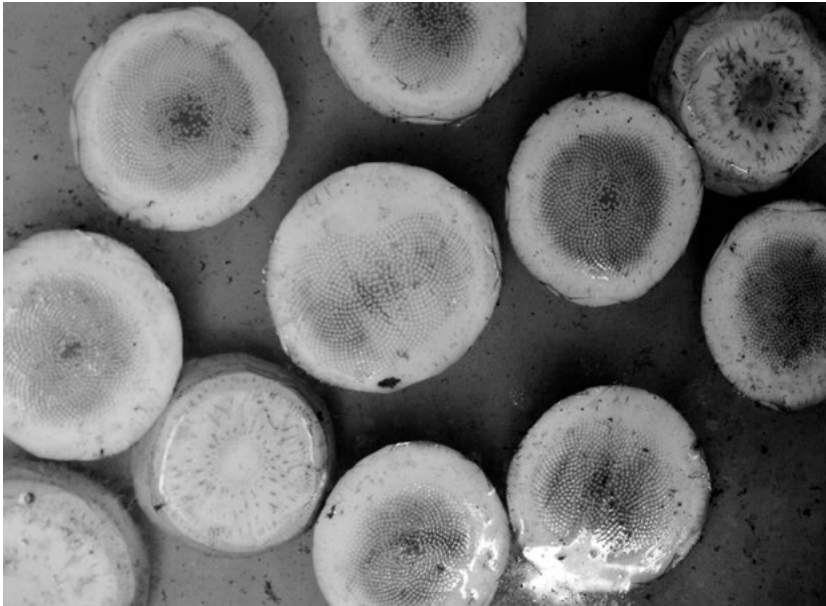


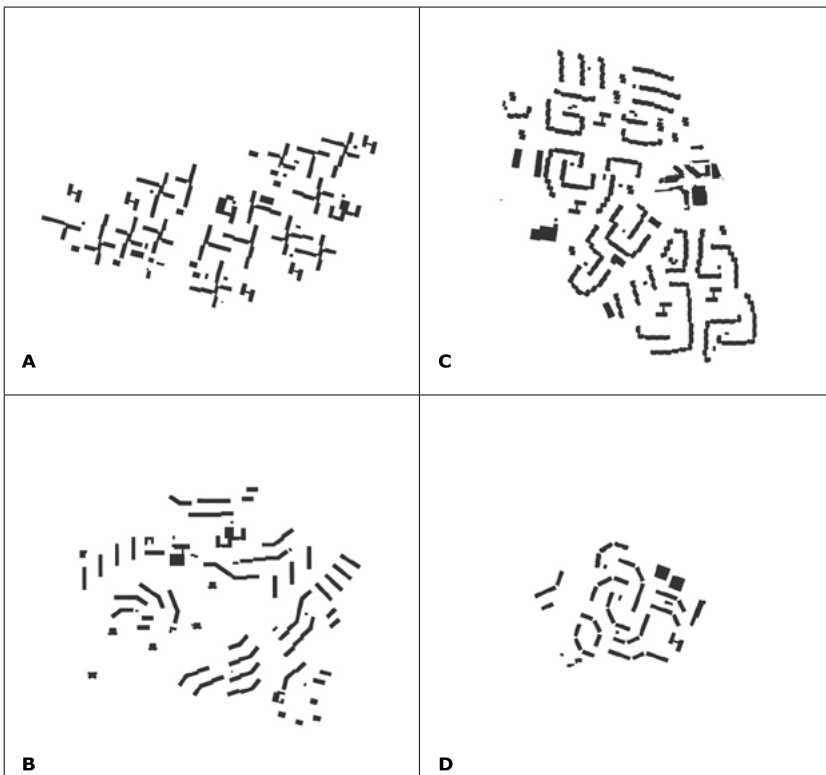
Urban Monads

Urban Monads are based on a holistic approach nature and phenomena. To German philosopher Gottfried W. Leibnitz, a monad is an indivisible unit— an initial unit of a perceived reality. The concept of urban monads interprets a monad as a coalition of a fragment and a unit. The monad here is also an extension of space, a formation of reproductive coherence between micro and macro worlds.
